DID YOU KNOW?

Women who viewed video out-ranked the non-viewer control group in behavior change-

26.5% vs. 4.9% started taking calcium

20.6 vs. 6.6% started taking vitamin D

13.% vs. 1.7% started weight-bearing exercises.

Osteoporosis – Behavior Change Study

When viewing video patient learning time is cut by almost 50%, with almost 24% more retention.

Video delivery can increase information retention by up to 16 times over that of text alone.

At least 75% of all patients leave the health provider office or hospital without appropriate or supporting information to explain their illness, injury, or treatment protocols. The healthcare industry now spends an unnecessary \$73 billion per year in hospital stays and doctors visits simply because patients don't understand what their doctor is explaining.

Analysis of plans from more than 200 employers showed an average medical cost ROI of \$3.48 for every \$1 spent.

And, researchers have estimated that preventable illnesses make up approximately 70% of the burden of illness.

Consumers spend an average of 30 minutes searching for healthcare information on the Internet and when employing English search engines they have only a 1 in 5 chance of finding relevant information from the first page of the results. Consumers using Spanish search engines have only a 1 in 9 chance of finding relevant information.
